WHO WE ARE

Global food systems account for roughly one quarter of total anthropogenic greenhouse gas emissions and close to 60% of global biodiversity loss. Despite this, only around 2% of global climate finance is directed towards agriculture and related sectors.

The ClimateShot Investor Coalition (CLIC) is an action-oriented group for leaders in the impact investment community working in agriculture and food systems globally.

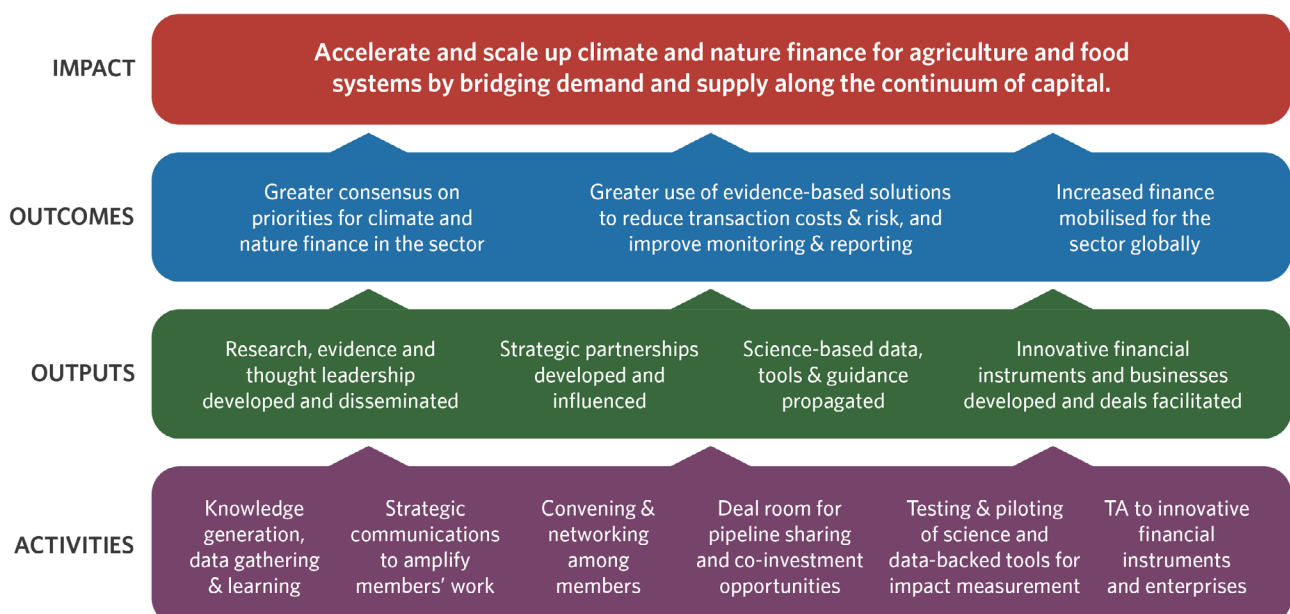

To achieve this goal, we are building a member-driven coalition with a focus on three key outcomes:

1. Greater consensus on priorities for climate and nature finance in the sector.
2. Greater use of evidence-based solutions to reduce transaction costs & risk, and improve monitoring & reporting.
3. Increased finance mobilised for the sector globally.

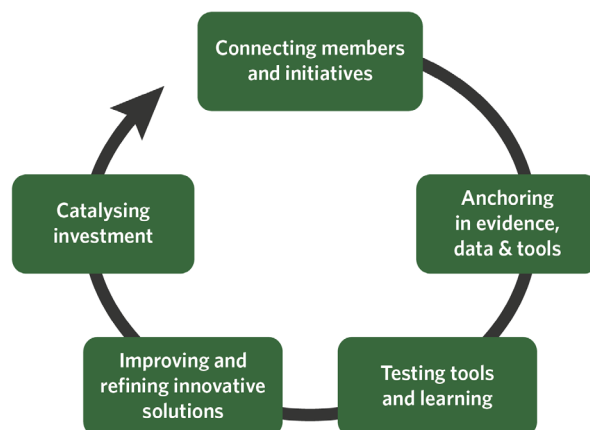
OUR THEORY OF CHANGE

CLIC will:

- Facilitate exchange between the diverse leaders within the coalition while also connecting with aligned initiatives to explore efficiencies and amplify efforts.
- Promote cutting-edge evidence, data and science-based tools for decision making in investments and impact measurement.
- Support members to test innovative, science-based tools and approaches in their operations and share lessons.
- Assess tools and approaches' effectiveness, then refine them and use them to build innovative financial solutions.
- Support members to incorporate innovative solutions in their investment decisions to catalyse additional finance at speed.



WHAT MAKES US UNIQUE

CLIC is uniquely designed to:

- Harness and facilitate financial innovation able to address barriers to investments in the sector through blended finance (including result-based payments and monetising climate and nature benefits).
- Catalyse the use of science and innovation in the impact investment ecosystem, including by spearheading a research agenda on what is needed to unlock additional finance.
- Achieve a systemic and transformational impact for climate mitigation, adaptation, and resilience as well as nature in support of the 2030 Agriculture Breakthrough Goal.
